


## Materials

Frame:	plywood, chipboard			
Upholstery:	combined 80 kg/m³ RE (rebound R-type foam) – 30 mm and 50 kg/m³ HR (high resilience) – 60 mm layers of urethane on zigzag springs in the seat; 40 kg/m³ HR (high resilience) 60mm layer of polyurethane in the back			
Cover:	textile vinyl leather			
Legs:	painted metal frame (rectangular tube 40×25mm and 30×30mm, powder coating, antracite grey (RAL 7016)), plastic glides.
